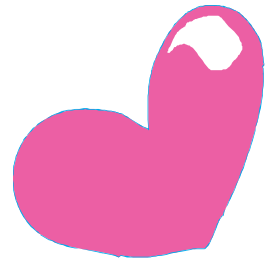
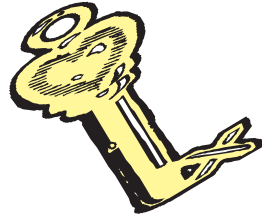


# The \_\_\_\_\_ to your \_\_\_\_\_
