## Notes From Mr. Rockhold.....

Uniontown High School was awarded a Certificate of Merit as part of the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Challenge Awards. This award recognizes schools for outstanding achievement and uncommon accomplishment based on Kansas Assessment results from 2011. Uniontown High School was awarded a Certificate of Merit for 7<sup>th</sup> grade math, and a second Certificate of Merit for 7<sup>th</sup> grade reading. For each of the fourteen state assessments, 60 state schools were originally identified as high performing. From those 60, the top score from ten regions was selected for a Certificate of Merit. In all, 95 certificates were awarded with 26 buildings receiving two or more awards.

The awards were presented to 37 different school districts (there are 297 districts in Kansas) and Uniontown High School was one of the 26 buildings receiving two or more awards.
