These two columns will be devoted to crossword puzzles, sudoku, word problems, word searches, and anything else that might challenge your brain.

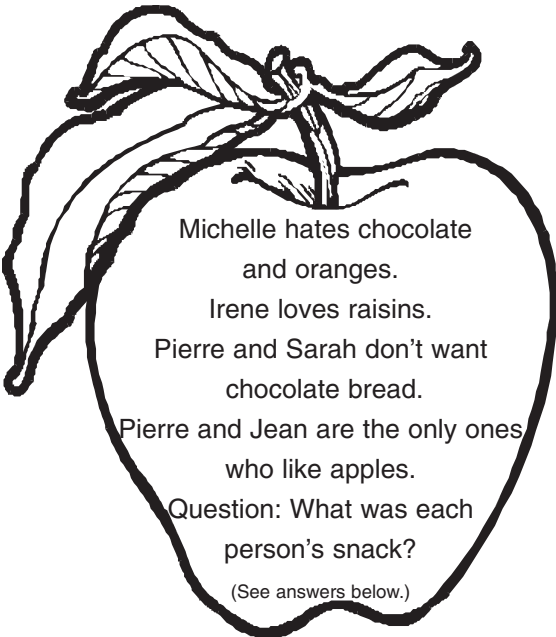
Each issue will have something different

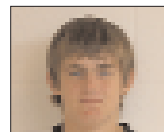

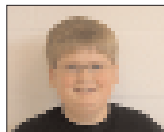
